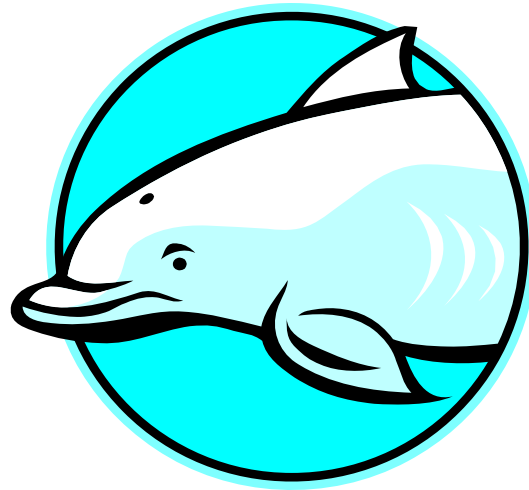

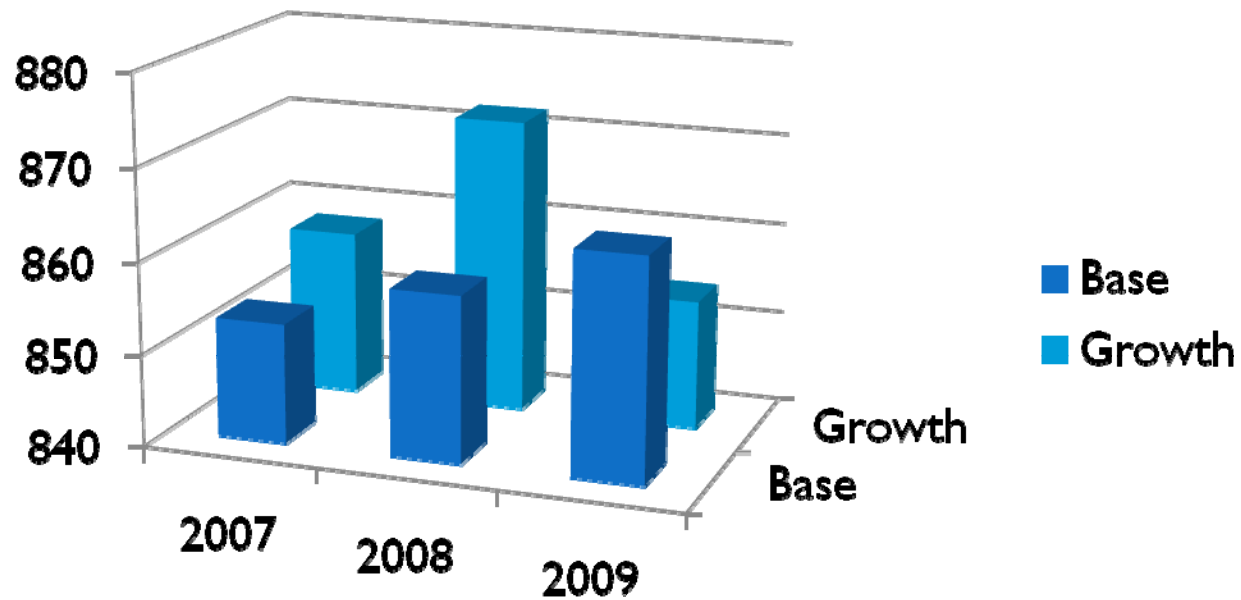

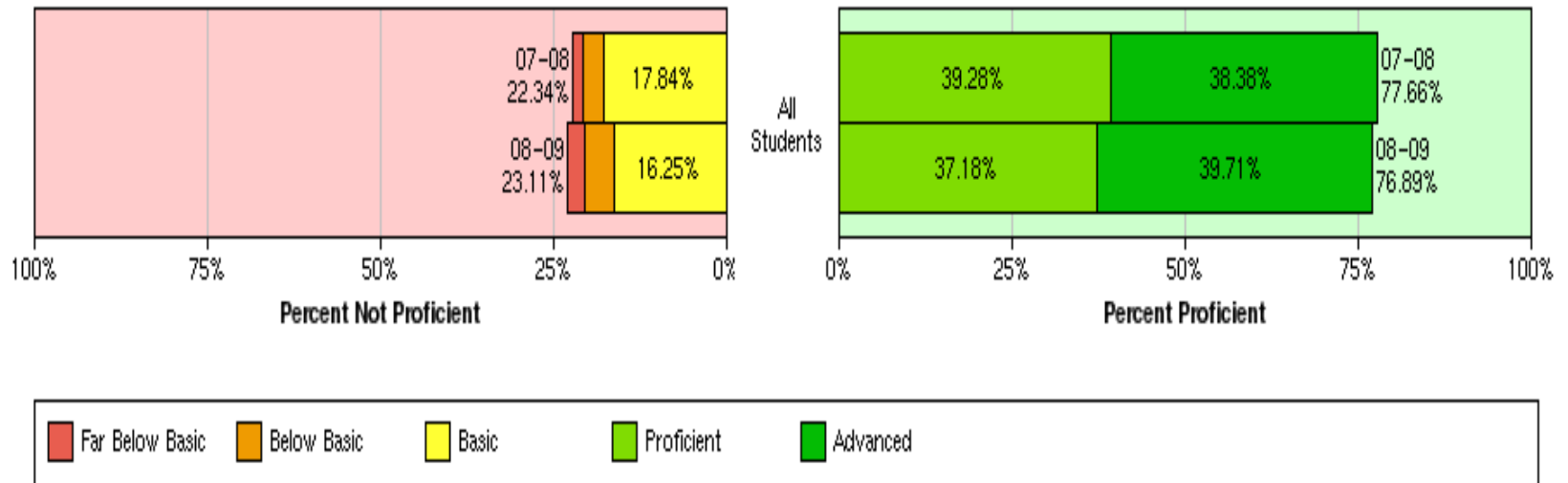
SVMS Academic Performance Index (API) Growth

Trend Analysis Graph

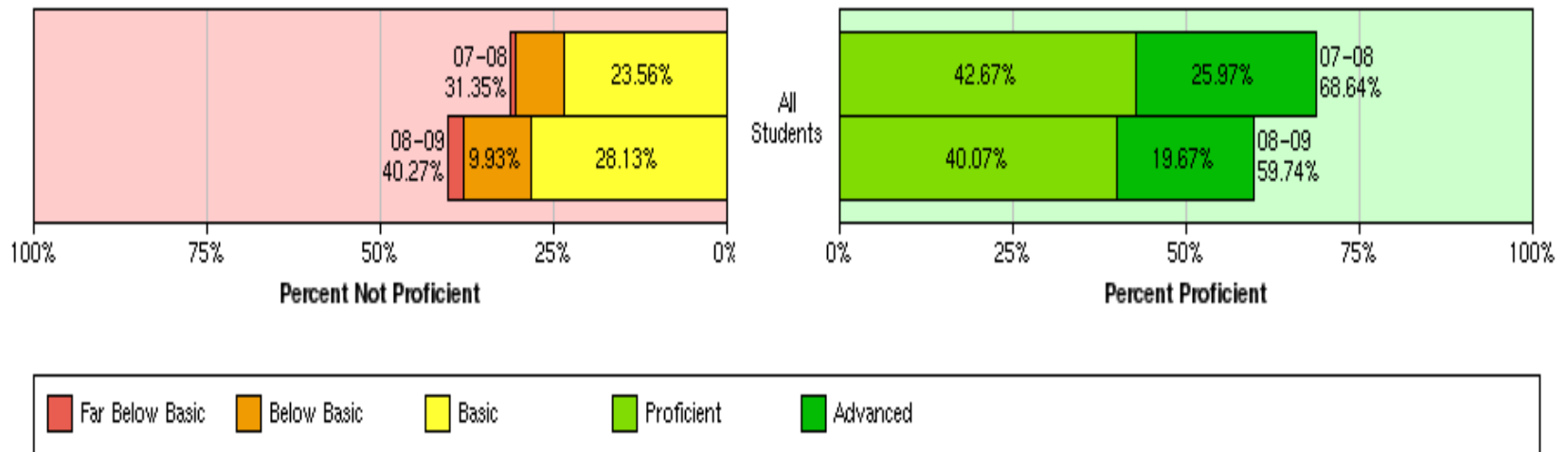


Reflections: Slight decrease in overall proficiency. Grades 6 and 8 showed slight percentage increases in the Proficient and Advanced categories. In grade 7, there was a 4% decrease in Proficient and Advanced categories.

Goal: To increase percentage of students in our critical subgroups to meet AYP targets

Trend Analysis Graph

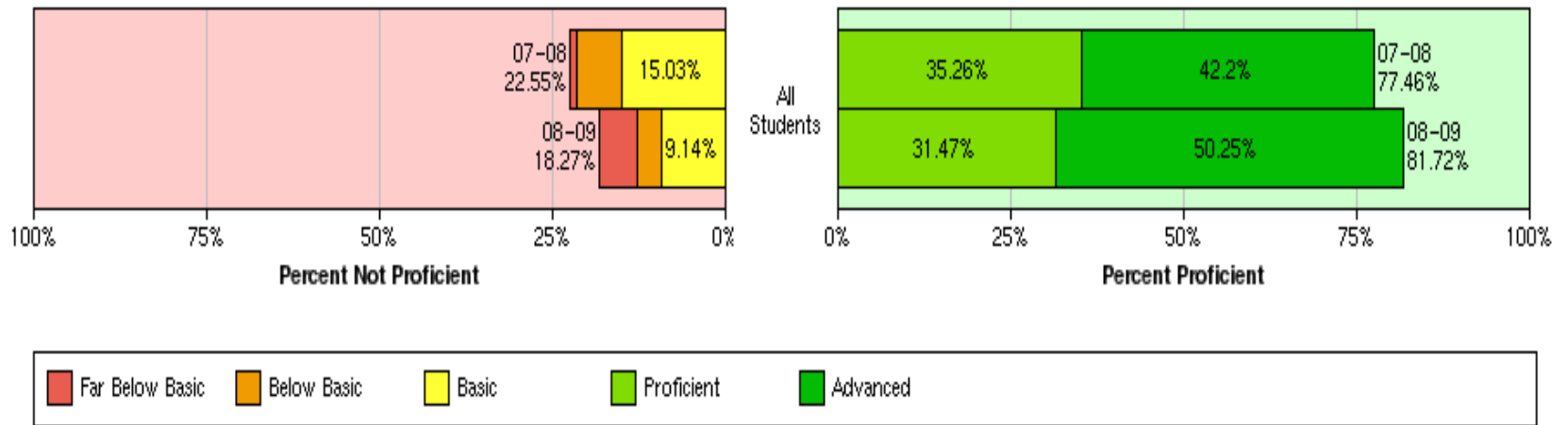


Reflections: 100% of Geometry and Algebra 7 students scored in the Proficient or Advanced range. In grades 6 and 7, there was an average percentage decrease of 5% in the Proficient and Advanced categories. In grade 8, there was a 17% decrease in Proficient and Advanced scores.

Goal: Increase percentage of students in the Proficient and Advanced categories by 11% with special consideration for the targeted subgroups.

Trend Analysis Graph

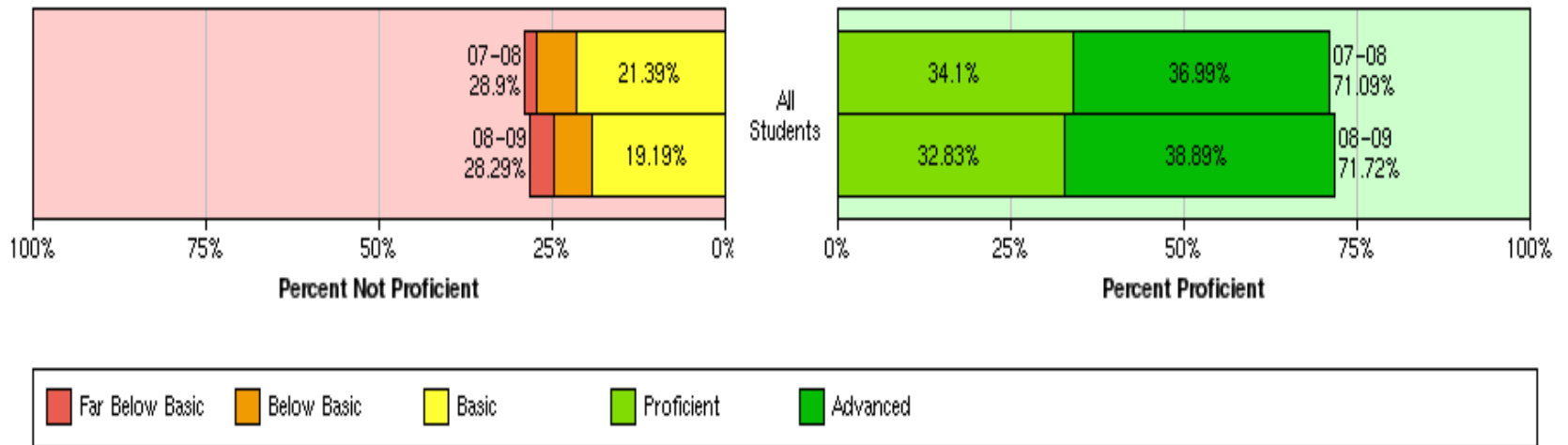


Reflections: Approximately 4 % increase of students scoring in the Proficient and Advanced ranges. Additionally, an approximately 6% decrease in students scoring in the Basic and below categories.

Goal: Increase percentage of students in the Proficient and Advanced ranges to 85%.

Reflections: Slight increase in percentage of students scoring in the Proficient and Advanced ranges. Slight decrease in students scoring in the non-proficient range.

Goal: Increase percentage of students in the Proficient and Advanced ranges from 70% to 75%.



Meeting the Needs of our Students
