IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES RECEIVE INFORMATION ON REPORTS FOR SCOTTS VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION'S 2011-12 ACCOUNTABILITY PROGRESS REPORTING (APR) SYSTEM.

BACKGROUND: The California Department of Education's Accountability Progress Reporting (APR) system provides an integrated approach to reporting results for state and federal accountability requirements. The Public Schools Accountability Act of 1999 created an academic accountability system for K-12 public education in California known as the API, Academic Performance Index. Its purpose is to measure the academic performance and growth of schools. The federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 created an accountability system called Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) which includes a series of annual academic performance goals established for each school, Local Education Agency (LEA), and the state as a whole. Districts receive the API and AYP reports typically in September.
