

SCOTTS VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

Board Meeting: September 18, 2012

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES APPROVE THE FORMATION OF A STRATEGIC PLAN SUBCOMMITTEE TO ADDRESS ONGOING PROGRESS TOWARD IMPLEMENTING ACTION STEPS AND TO PROPOSE REVISIONS OF THE SCOTTS VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT STRATEGIC PLAN.

BACKGROUND: On March 23, 2012, the Strategic Planning Committee reconvened, engaging a broad base of staff, students and community members. The purpose of the meeting was to inform participants about the district's Strategic Plan, goals, progress over the past year and receive their views. Participants were involved in groups to focus on strategies for improving communication throughout the district toward building support and understanding of the District's fiscal challenges. Babs Kavanaugh served as facilitator of the process.

**DESCRIPTION
DETAILS:**

The Strategic Plan Subcommittee (SPS) is recommended to be convened for the purpose of tracking and measuring progress on the goals and to recommend revisions to goals and action steps to the larger SP Committee annually. The subcommittee is planned to convene for the 2012-2013 school year for the purpose of responding to changing requirements and the subsequent plan for change within the District to include major issues such as the implementation of the Common Core State Standards, an evolving system of assessment and student achievement data management as well as sustaining a high-performing learning community. The SPS (Strategic Planning Subcommittee) will meet 3 to 4 times a year for in-depth work sessions on goals and objectives that will be presented to the full Strategic Planning Committee for articulation and revision. Further, the District's Leadership Team will create action plans that carry out the goals and objectives of the Strategic Plan. These will be presented and carried forward into Single Plans for Student Achievement (SPSA) which are presented for Board approval in the Fall. As a subcommittee, it is the recommendation of staff that the SPS be identified as a Superintendent's committee not subject to the requirements of the Brown Act for meetings.
