IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES APPROVE BROOK KNOLL'S FOURTH GRADE OVERNIGHT FIELD TRIPS TO COLOMA AND SACRAMENTO.

**BACKGROUND:** As described in Board Policy 6153, the Board of Trustees recognizes school-sponsored trips as important components of a student's development. All trips involving out-of-state or overnight travel require prior approval of the Board.

**DESCRIPTION  
DETAILS:**

Brook Knoll teachers are requesting approval of their annual fourth grade trip to Coloma and Sacramento to support their year-long study of California history. Students will visit the State Capitol, Sutter's Fort, the State Railroad Museum and Marshall Gold Discovery State Historic Park, and will stay overnight at the Coloma Resort. Dates for the proposed trip are as follows:

- March 28 and 29: Ms. Rugg and Ms. Patterson and Ms. Martin's SDC fourth grade students
- May 10 and 11: Ms. Muehlhauser and Ms. Santos

Classes will travel by bus and be accompanied by seven to ten parent volunteers for each class. Classes have raised the funds to support this trip by selling tubs of cookie dough.
