NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Education of the Scotts Valley Unified School District will hold a public hearing on May 11, 2010, at 6:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, to consider adoption of a resolution entitled “RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE SCOTTS VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT ADOPTING RESPONSES TO PUBLIC COMMENTS RECEIVED, APPROVING A SCHOOL FACILITIES NEEDS ANALYSIS, ADOPTING ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL FACILITY FEES IN COMPLIANCE WITH GOVERNMENT CODE SECTIONS 65995.5, 65996.6, 65995.7 AND MAKING RELATED FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS” which would, if approved, adopt the School Facilities Needs Analysis for Consideration of Alternative School Facility Fees, dated April 8, 2010 and authorize the levy of Alternative Level 2 (\$3.37 per square foot) and/or Level 3 (\$6.74 per square foot) School Impact Mitigation Fees under Senate Bill 50. The fee would be for new and expanded school facilities to serve students generated from new development. The School Facilities Needs Analysis justifying the increase in these fees has been prepared and will be available for public review at the District Administration Office on and after April 12, 2010, located at 4444 Scotts Valley Drive, Suite 5B, Scotts Valley California. The hearing will be held at the Scotts Valley City Council Chambers, One Civic Center Drive, Scotts Valley, California.

PUBLIC HEARING TO REVIEW AND CONSIDER ADOPTION OF A REPORT ENTITLED “SCHOOL FACILITIES NEEDS ANALYSIS” PREPARED AS OF APRIL 2010 TO CONSIDER AND RESPOND TO ALL COMMENTS RECEIVED BY THE DISTRICT RELATED TO THE ADOPTION OF ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL FEES.

BACKGROUND: In order to impose alternative school fees (“Alternative School Fees”), known as Level 2 Fees a school district must meet specified statutory requirements set forth in Government Code Sections 65995.5, 65995.6 and 65995.7, as well as Ed Code section 17620.

DESCRIPTION

DETAILS: The Level 2 Fee is intended to represent fifty percent (50%) of a school district’s school facilities costs, and applies when the State Allocations Board is apportioning state funding to school districts. To impose Alternative School Fees the District must prepare and adopt a school district’s school facilities needs analysis (SFNA). The Dolinka Group has prepared the 2010 SFNA dated April 12, 2010.
